The application submission process will open April 13th and will close June 15th. The completed packet must be received by the June 15th deadline for your application to be considered. This wide window is to ensure that you have ample time to collect recommendations. It is recommended that you should start this section first. If there are any documents that you are unable to collect, please reach out to me sooner rather than later so I can see what we can do. Please be advised that if you are chosen to receive this honor, you may be required to attend a suitable public event for a ceremonial presentation. It is also important to note that the limit

World Tang Soo Do Region 2 Scholarship General Requirements

- 1). All applicants must be currently enrolled in a certified World Tang Soo Do Association studio, located in U.S. regions only.
 - 2). All applicants must be current members, in good standing, of the World Tang Soo Do Association. All WTSDA membership dues must be current.
 - 3). All applicants must have completed a minimum of one year of training at a World Tang Soo Do Association Region 2 registered studio.
 - 4). Applicants are to return application material via the google form (with either clear picture or scanned file unless otherwise approved)
 - 5). The scholarship awards are open to full time students in their senior year of high school (or a senior by time of award), full time students currently attending a college or university, and students pursuing an advanced degree (graduate or doctorate degree), and those attending vocational, trade, or any similar accredited school.
 - 6). All applicants must have a minimum GPA of 2.5 on a 4.0 scale.
 - 7). All applicants must submit their most recent **official** high school or college transcript.
 - 8). All applicants must submit 3 recommendation forms, one from each of the following areas:
 - a. Instructor's recommendation from their WTSDA instructor.
 - b. Academic recommendation from a teacher, guidance counselor or advisor.
 - c. Personal recommendation from a non-family member.
- *Please use the forms provided. Also note that since the recommendation requirements are the same for both the Region 2 and Region 2, it is permissible to use the same recommendation letters, given that they are not specifically addresses to only be used for the World Tang Soo Do Region 2 Scholarship.
- 9). All applicants must submit a minimum 500-word essay entitled "How Tang Soo Do Has Made a Difference in My Life".
 - 10). All applicants must submit a separate letter describing their educational goals.
 - 11). All interested parties may request an application packet in writing from the WTSDA Scholarship Contact or their studio head, or may download it from the Region 2 website. The WTSDA Region 2 Scholarship Chair may be reached at at the following address:
